NISQUALLY YOUTH AND COMMUNITY CENTER AUTHORIZED USER POLICY

The Nisqually Youth and Community Center (NYCC) serves the Nisqually Tribal Community and multiple Tribal Departments. The Nisqually Tribal Council has established the following guidelines for use of NYCC facilities by Tribal programs and other users. Those that DO NOT meet this criterion are not authorized to use the NYCC facilities.

Tribal Program Use

The NYCC is home to the Nisqually Youth Program and the Nisqually Health, Fitness & Nutrition Program. Programs located at the NYCC will generally have first priority for facility use. Except as described below, access to the NYCC facility during normal hours of operation is limited to authorized clients and participants in these Tribal programs.

Nisqually Tribal Members

Enrolled members of the Nisqually Indian Tribe have access to the NYCC during normal hours of operation and as specified in the Department Policies of the Nisqually Youth Program and the Nisqually Health, Fitness & Nutrition Program. Facility use by individual Tribal Members must not conflict with Tribal program use. In the event of a conflict Tribal Programs have priority.

Nisqually Tribal Employees

Current employees of the Nisqually Tribal Government are permitted to access to the NYCC during normal hours of operation as specified in the Department Policies of the Nisqually Youth Program and the Nisqually Health, Fitness & Nutrition Program.

Community Members

Community Members include residents of the Nisqually Reservation; persons who participate regularly in community events hosted by the Tribe and persons residing in Nisqually Tribal Member households. Department Directors have discretion to determine who is a Community Member for purposes of this policy. Community Members have access to the NYCC during normal hours of operation as specified in the Department Policies of the Nisqually Youth Program and the Nisqually Health, Fitness & Nutrition Program.

Events

The NYCC is also used regularly for events (Community Dinners, General Council Meetings, Birthday Parties, etc.). Access to the facility for events is determined by the organizers of the event.
